

COUNTY COMMISSIONER – DISTRICT #4

Due to the resignation of Stephanie Brown, the Clare County Board of Commissioners is seeking interested individuals who reside and are registered to vote in County Commissioner District #4 to serve on the Clare County Board of Commissioners until the primary election to be held on August 2, 2022.

Commissioner District #4 comprises of all of Grant Township, Hatton Township and the southern portion of Hayes Township.

The duties of a county commissioner include setting policy and approving budgets as part of a seven-member County Board of Commissioners in an organization of approximately 200 total employees and a budget of approximately \$13 million.

The individual must reside and be a registered voter in Commissioner District #4 to represent the citizens of Commission District #4 and be available to attend official meetings of the Clare County Board of Commissioners that meet at 9:00 a.m. on the 3rd Wednesday of each month and a variety of other meetings.

Interested individuals shall submit a resume or statement of interest in writing no later than Monday, April 18, 2022 to the Office of the County Administrator, 225 W. Main St., PO Box 438, Harrison, MI. 48625.

Applicants must be available for a brief interview between 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 20, 2022.

The position will be filled at the April 20, 2022 meeting of the Clare County Board of Commissioners.
