|  |  | <p>For the purpose of authorizing funding for the Clare County Gypsy Moth Suppression Program to monitor, control, and reduce Gypsy Moth outbreaks in Clare County, shall the constitutional limitation upon the total amounts of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Clare, Michigan be increased by up to 1.0000 of one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of state taxable valuation), for a period of five (5) years, from 2020 through 2024, inclusive? If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated additional \$1,131,201.33 in the first calendar year of the levy, based on state taxable valuation, to operate the Clare County Gypsy Moth Suppression Program.
