

The following Ordinance was adopted by the Clare County Board of Commissioners on September 1, 1999 and is effective upon publishing:

**ORDINANCE #18A**

An Ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the County of Clare under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act (Act #230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended).

The County of Clare ordains:

- Section 1. Agency designated, pursuant to the provision of the Michigan Electrical Code, in a accordance with Section 9 of Act 230, P.A. 1972, as amended, the Electrical Official of the County of Clare is hereby designated as the Enforcing Agency to discharge the responsibility of Clare County under Act 230, P.A., as amended, State of Michigan. The County of Clare assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said act throughout its corporate limits.
- Section 2. Repeals, all Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Section 3. Publication. This Ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with provisions of the act governing same.
