

Due to the Covid-19 virus, the following operations of the Clare County Sheriff's Office have been implemented.

Front Office has suspended the following:

There will be no PBT's

There will be no Drug Screening

There will be No Fingerprinting

Immediate front lobby only will remain open while the secondary waiting lobby will be closed.

Road Patrol Response: Minor incidents / non progress calls will be handled via telephone if feasible

Walk in complaints will be handled in the immediate lobby area

Traffic Enforcement as needed

Investigation will be conducted outside of building as much as possible

Will not be responding to Peace Officer Assists unless a threat of assault is imminent

Will only respond to priority one medical calls

Civil Papers – Attempt telephone to arrange for pick-up. If not, attempt as possible. Personal Protection Orders should be attempted if possible.

No Out County Warrant pick-ups

Jail Operations: No new SST intakes

No Warrant pick-up unless of a violent Felony

No Friend Of Court Pick-ups

No Temporary holds unless of a violent Felony

Weekenders postponed until April 10, 2020 @ 2100 hrs. unless otherwise notified

No Court ordered Preliminary Breath Test at the front counter

Only CCSD employee's and essential staff allowed in the jail

- No Attorney client visits (Homewav or Poly-com only)
- No DHS / CPS / CMH (EMERGENCIES ONLY)
