FULL-TIME EMERGENCY 911 TELECOMMUNICATOR

-CLARE COUNTY CENTRAL DISPATCH

Applications are now being accepted by Clare County Central Dispatch to fill a full-time position within the dispatch center as an Emergency 911 Telecommunicator.

- This position requires staff to work weekends and holidays for 24/7 shift coverage
- Telecommunicators work (6) 12 hour shifts and (1) 8 hour shift every two weeks with the possibility of voluntary or mandated overtime per union contract.
- Applicants must be 18 years of age with a high school diploma or equivalent. Applicants must also pass a background check with fingerprint screening, a drug screen and pre-employment health examination.
- Applicant must have high moral and ethical standards, excellent communication, listening and voice skills and the ability to deal with stressful conditions.
- Starting pay is \$13.73, topping out at \$17.88 after 4 years. *The starting rate of pay may be negotiable with prior dispatching experience.
- Application packets consisting of the Clare County Sheriff Department employment application, resume and cover letter, must be submitted to the Sheriff Dept with attention to: Clare County Central Dispatch, no later than 4pm on Friday, May 16th 2020. Late applications will not be considered.
