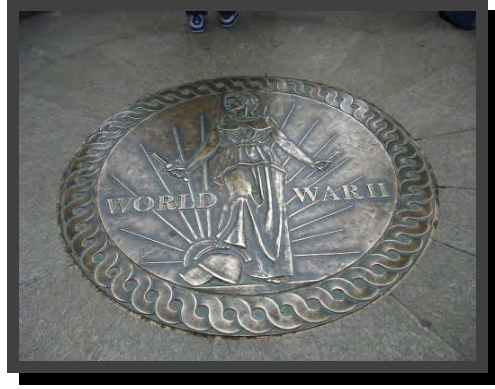

## WHO WE ARE

Mid-Michigan Honor Flight is a Regional Hub of the Honor Flight Network. Honor Flight Network is the national organization who is behind this massive effort to see that ALL Veterans have the opportunity to see their memorials, FREE OF CHARGE.

It is no secret that we lose 500-700 World War II Veterans each day and in three - five years it is estimated that *they will all be gone.*

Our mission is to send WWII Veterans in the Mid-Michigan area - from Traverse City to Lansing and across the state - to see the monument that honors their service and sacrifice. But time is running out fast!!

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO GO ON THE FLIGHT?

WWII Veterans will have first priority; and any terminally ill Veteran from any time; then Korean War Veterans.

## WHO ELSE CAN GO?

We are asking for Guardians to escort these heroes to Washington, D.C. Many Guardians are needed as we are focused on the safety and security of our Veterans.

Guidelines for Guardians:

- must be between 18 – 70 years old and in good health.
- must be willing to pay for their own trip (est. \$500.00)
- priority will be given for anyone with medical training or a Veteran.
- family members and others will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
