

Clare County Solid Waste Blight Program

The program is new and is designed to assist cities, townships, villages, and other non-profit organizations in Clare County to alleviate frustrating influences and deteriorating conditions. For residents who have no other means to get the work done, the county will provide a drop-off container(s). The sponsoring organization will load the container(s) while sorting out metal for recycling and prohibited waste. The container(s) will be dropped off, picked up and disposed of, **at no cost** to residents or sponsors.

Application must be made to Clare County Solid Waste Coordinator after December 1 and before April 30 of each year.

The Solid Waste Advisory Committee will make awards in June and work must be completed by October.

Sponsor Responsibilities

Make application on forms provided.
Get authorization for the container(s) to be placed in driveway.
Sort load for metal recyclables and prohibited waste.
Load container(s).
